Distinguished Speakers

1. Swami Sarvapriyananda has been the Minister and spiritual leader of the Vedanta Society of New York since January 2017. He joined the Ramakrishna Math in 1994 and received sannyasa in 2004. He served as an acharya (teacher) of the monastic probationers' training center at Belur Math, India. He also served in various capacities in different educational institutes of the Ramakrishna Mission in India and as the Assistant Minister of the Vedanta Society of Southern California. During 2019-2020 he was a Nagral Fellow at the Harvard Divinity School. He is a well-known speaker on Vedanta and his talks are extremely popular globally via the internet. He has been a speaker on various prestigious forums such as TEDx, SAND, Google Talk etc. He has also been invited to speak at several universities across the world, including Harvard University. The swami has engaged in dialogue with many eminent thinkers such as Deepak Chopra, Rupert Spira, Rick Archer, David Chalmers and Sam Harris. He has played a prominent role in organizing and participating in various interfaith panels and seminars, including speaking at the World Parliament of Religions in Toronto in 2018, and at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

2. Professor Soma Sen, School of Social Work, San Jose State University. She holds a Dual Masters Degree in Economics and Community & Regional Planning from Iowa State University and a Master's Degree in Social Work from the University of Minnesota. She was one of the core team members of the Social Work Education Enhancement Program (SWEEP) a UNAIDS-funded project on Social Work Education in Vietnam. Recently she served as the Co-PI on the European Union- funded grant "Building Social Capital by Improving Multicultural Competence in Higher Education and Labour Market" which aimed at promoting and enhancing multicultural competence in highereducation.

3. Professor Ena Ray Banerjee, is currently a Senior Professor of Zoology at, the University of Calcutta, India and leads the Translational Outcomes Research Group that focuses on Immunobiology and regenerative Medicine, drug discovery studies and basic research, including the development and validation of novel drugs, functional food, nutraceuticals, antibody and tissue engineering of stem cells in inflammatory and degenerative diseases for

which her team holds several patents, publications and grants..She has contributed to transdisciplinary higher education, science popularization and outreach, and promotes innovation involving science and society.

4. Ms Jahnabi Phookan, An entrepreneur for over three decades. Her companies are encompassed in travel and hospitality - boutique river cruising, small group specialized tours, tea and textiles - all of which empower young people's livelihoods, especially women and their communities. Her Mission "Sustainable Practices and Sustainable Livelihoods for women's economic upliftment" led to the adoption of 143 villages, to empower a microcosm of rural women in her 17 chapters, Pan India. Since 2007, Ms Phookan has been involved in Assam''s cottage industry of weaving when she started Lahé Looms to enable a sustainable livelihood model to rural women by providing quality yarn and collecting their produce from their doorsteps, through her band of weavers. In 2011, Jahnabi set up her handloom weaving centre next to her wildlife lodge, the Diphlu River Lodge in Kaziranga. Lahé Looms under the registered company Lahé Lifestyle works towards the promotion of Assam''s unique weaving vernacular (Lahé denotes slow=organic). For her efforts in this sector, Ms Phookan has been appointed a member of the Handloom Committee under the Ministry of Textiles in Sept 2021.

5. Mr Prabhat Bezbaruah (PHD) An alumnus of IIM Calcutta, he joined Bank of America, where he worked in Bombay, Madras, Calcutta and Manila. He pursued a PhD in Finance at The Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, where he taught Options and Futures to BBA students for a while. Returning to India in 1988, he looked after his family"s tea business from around 1990. Under his leadership, the business has grown from a base of 5 lakh kilos, both organically and through acquisitions, and today produces around 12 million kilos of black tea. During his tea career, he has been Chairman of Assam Tea Planters" Association for two terms, Director of Assam Tea CorporationLtd., Economic Adviser to the Chief Minister, Assam, Member Board of Governors Indian Institute of Plantation Management for five terms, Member Tea Board for two terms, Member SN Menon Committee on Plantation Sector Reforms, Member Tea Advisory Committee under Commerce Ministry, Director Assam Power Distribution Company Ltd., Chairman Tea Research Association (Tocklai) for two terms, Chairman Tea Board India for two terms, and President National TeaResearch Foundation and Labour Market" which aimed at promoting and enhancing multicultural competence in higher education.
