Activity Report: Responding to the Nation's call by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, IGNOU Regional Centre Kolkata took initiative and undertook various activities under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan.

Free health Check up camp at Regional Centre:

In tune with the government initiatives taken for overall development of rural and remote areas under the aegis of 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, the Regional Centre Kolkata organized a Free Health Camp at Regional Centre premises on 14th September, 2018 with the help of Medica Superspecialty Hospital. The objective of the camp was to provide free medical check-up and preventive measures and create awareness on the need for personal hygiene in prevention of serious disabling diseases to the local community. The medical camp witnessed a steady flow of patients throughout the day and many were benefitted through this camp. More than 100 patients (including adults, children) availed the service and consultation from the team of Doctors. Overall the camp was a huge success and we create many smiling faces there.

Awareness campaign under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan in the adopted villages:

Regional Centre Kolkata carried a campaign to make its adopted villages plastic free. It also laid emphasis on the necessity on the conservation of water. On a very auspicious day of 2nd October, 2019 villagers at Dumdumi, Ledabera and Khirinda took out a procession to create awareness on refraining from use of plastic and committed to make their village plastic free. Regional Centre with the help of its Learners Support Centres 2824D and 2891D campaigns for promotion of eco-friendly bags like cloth or jute instead of plastic in the adopted villages.
